Rain barrels are a simple, affordable way to conserve water and help protect our local environment. By collecting rainwater from your roof, a rain barrel stores water that would otherwise run off into streets, storm drains, and nearby waterways.

Homeowners can use this free water for gardens, flowers, lawns, and landscaping. Rainwater is naturally soft and free of many chemicals found in treated water, making it great for plants while helping reduce household water use and summer water bills.

Rain barrels also help protect our watershed. When rain runs off hard surfaces like roofs and driveways, it can carry soil, fertilizers, oil, and other pollutants into streams and rivers. Capturing some of that rainwater helps slow runoff, reduce pollution, and ease pressure on local drainage systems.

Installing a rain barrel is an easy step that benefits your garden, your wallet, and our shared water resources.
